

Sloped/ widened sunvisors installation instructions

* NOT INSTALLING SUPPORT BRACKET MAY CAUSE CAB ROOF DAMAGE*

- 1. Remove Plastic coating around all bolt holes.
- 2. Do not tighten bolts with locknuts all the way until last step.



- 3. Hold inner (inside cab) support bracket in place over center post of windshield and drill two center holes to line up with outer support bracket.
- 4. Install 1-1/2" Phillips head bolts through the column and fasten supplied nuts and washers.
- 5. Drill two remaining holes in column, finish fastening with bolts and nuts provided.
- 6. Install brackets on roof to line up with insert holes in roof making sure brackets are installed in their proper position (i.e.) center, outers, and inners. Do not tighten completely, use generous amounts of silicone to seal holes for leakage.
- 7. Install Sunvisor onto brackets while lining up holes. ¼" Phillips head bolts may be reused from original visor. Do not completely tighten bolts.
- 8. Install end bolts from original visor. Do nottighten completely.
- 9. Tighten all bolts beginning with visor into brackets, then tighten brackets to roof and ends.
