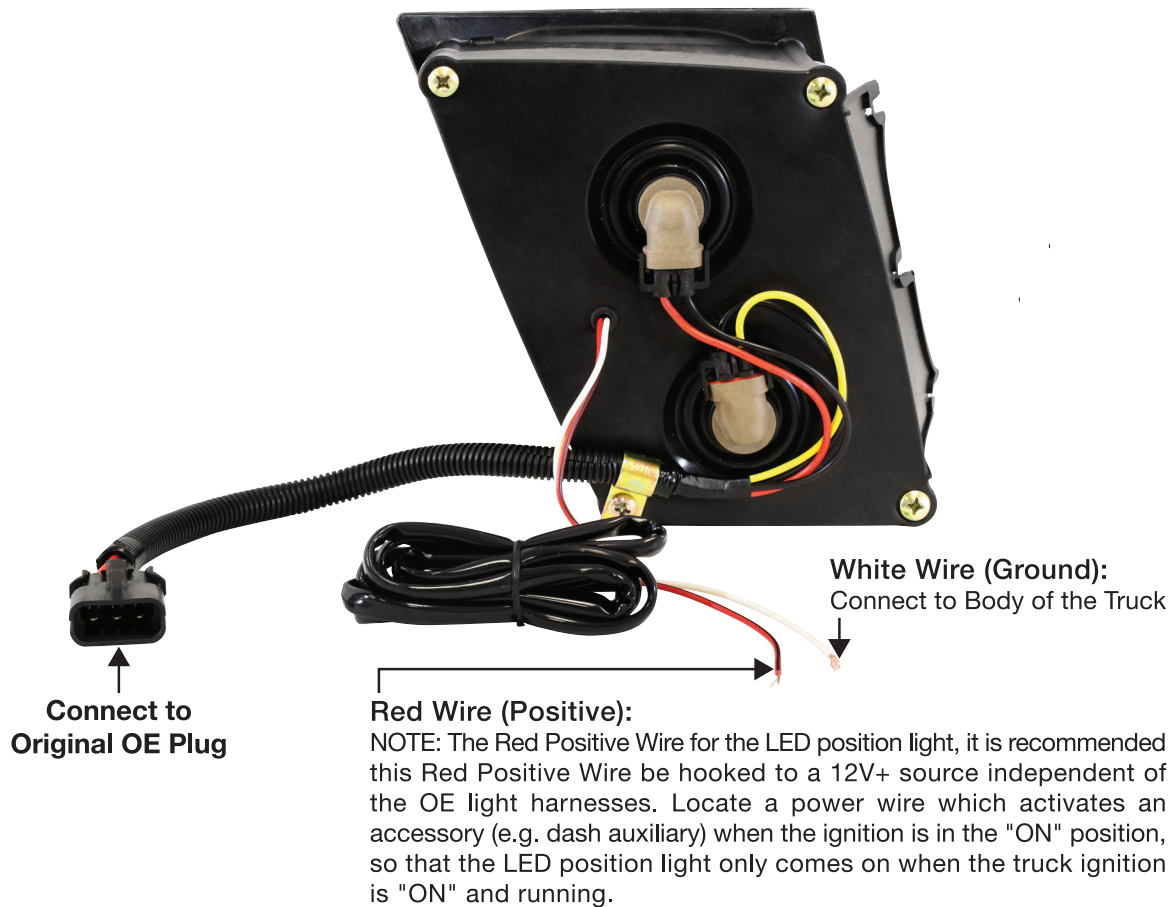




VOLVO VN / VNL FOG / DRIVING LIGHT

NORMAL FOGGING / CONDENSATION

On rare occasions, light fogging may occur. Light fogging is a normal occurrence and lamp assembly replacement **WILL NOT** be necessary.

A drop in air temperature may cause condensation to form on the inside of a cool lamp lens. Generally, fogging is considered normal and can be eliminated by turning on the lamp with the engine running for several minutes. In most cases, operating the vehicle in normal driving condition will clear the lamp fogging. Therefore, lamp assembly replacement **WILL NOT** be necessary in most cases.

NOTE:

- If any of the following conditions occur, please consult with a professional mechanic to determine the water source:
 - 1) If condensation/fogging fails to dissipate after operating the headlight with the engine running for 30 minutes
 - 2) If water pooled inside the lamp
- A high pressure washer may also cause water to be forced into the lamp assembly.
